Acting MD's News





Safety: Working at Heights

Whilst loading and unloading your vehicle using the tail lift, you are "Working at Heights". Some risks associated with this task are: falls, slips and trips and the dislodgement of the product from the rear of your vehicle.

How can we prevent or minimize the impact of these things from happening?

1. Ensure that proper PPE is worn at all times.

Steel cap boots with good soles need to be worn. No slippery joggers or other worn soled shoes.

2. When unloading the product, never pull the load walking backwards.

Ensure toe board is raised to prevent the load from falling off the rear of the vehicle.

3. Before stepping onto the tailgate, inspect the tailgate service to see if it is wet or there are any potential trip hazards.

If wet, proceed with caution and adjust loading/unloading procedure.

4. When climbing into the cab of the truck, always maintain 3 points of contact at all times.

Never jump from the cab or the tail lift, this may result in serious injuries.

Out of Office:






Book Week 17th to the 24th of August:
